7. OVERSEAS STUDENTS ON FIELDWORK ABROAD

In cases where students liable for fees at the 'overseas' rate spend a minimum of six consecutive months engaged on field-work abroad, the fee for such a period will be 50% of the appropriate full-time rate. The standard full-time fee will apply to any remaining part of the year spent in the UK.

8. FEES FOR 'WRITING UP'

Students first registered before 1 September 1996

Students first registered before 1 September 1996 who have completed the prescribed minimum period of attendance, have completed the work and require only minimal supervision and access to University facilities must pay an administration fee of **£93** £90 £84 per year or part of a year.

Students first registered on or after 1 September 1996

'Continuation' fee

Students first registered on or after 1 September 1996 who have completed the prescribed minimum period of attendance, have completed the work and require only minimal supervision and access to University facilities must pay a continuation fee of **£580** £560 £530 per year, payable as two six-monthly instalments of £290.

'Administration' fee

Students first registered on or after 1 September 1996 who have completed the prescribed minimum period of attendance, have completed the work and no longer require supervision and access to University facilities must pay an administration fee of **£93** £90 £84 per year or part of a year.

9. ALUMNI DISCOUNT

Students who have graduated with a degree-level qualification from a previous and separate programme at the University of Bath will be eligible for a discount of 10% on any part of their fees for which they are personally responsible. The discount will be applied just before payment of the tuition fee is due. In the event that a studentship or sponsorship covering all or part of the tuition fee is awarded after the start of the programme the discount will apply only to fees payable before the effective start date of the studentship or sponsorship, and only to fees not covered by the studentship or sponsorship thereafter.
