### 107 MINUTES

### 108 ARRANGEMENTS FROM AUGUST 2013

The Board considered Paper HM12/13-9, detailing proposed meeting arrangements and amended Terms of Reference for the Board following a change to the funding arrangements for the Holburne Museum.
