The Center for International Education, La Salle

(C.I.E.L.), through the Special Programs Dept. offers tailor-made programs for academic and/or professional needs for foreign groups coming to Mexico. Our programs offer a mix of academic classes, practical components and focused site visits targeted to specific learning outcomes. Full academic credit is given for these activities and can be transferred anywhere in the world.

A Summer Language and Culture Program is also offered in a unique four-week program with the option of Service Learning Placements in various organizations.

Placement exams, housing, excursions, language instruction and enrichment are included in the program package. Specialized services can be designed according to institutional requirements.

All programs integrate an intercultural session and field visits providing participants with practical immersion into the culture and society.

Doing Business in Mexico: Program focuses on Mexican economic situation with courses that familiarize students on current social and political issues that influence the business environment. Analysis of international trade and conditions and factors influencing Pacific Rim integration, Investment opportunities, Labor issues, IT industry in Mexico, Maquiladoras.

Field visits to: Embassy trade sector offices, Mexican government investment office, Consultants, manufacturing plant, small businesses.

■ Public Health in Mexico: Program provides students in the social and health care field an opportunity to experience firsthand the various facets of Health care. The program consists of academic lectures covering topics such National Health Care plans and policies, Elderly care, Medical Tourism, Traditional Medicine and Community Health Care.

Field visits to: old age home, HIV Clinic, local community health center, rehab clinic, public and private hospitals.

■ Criminal Justice in Mexico: The courses will introduce the social, legal, political, criminal, and penal systems in Mexico. Analysis of the current situation and the impact on public safety in Mexico is examined, and in the context of impact on society and influence in globalization of crime.

Field visits to: Local law enforcement offices, Attorney General training facilities, correctional facilities, Emergency Response Offices, NGO's involved in social justice and Human rights, community service centers.

■ Global Media in Mexico: Program designed to explore the current thinking on intercultural communication. Academic courses and guest speakers will focus on understanding Mexico's past and present and the role of media in the current political, economic, social context.

Field visits to: Television studio, Radio station, newspaper, web enterprises, telecommunications providers. Meetings with journalists and reporters.

Education in Mexico: Program that focuses on educational system in Mexico. Challenges of current education methods, policies, structure of federal educational model and the differences between the public and private systems.

Field visits to: Private and public elementary, secondary and high schools; orphanage, community service centers, Adult education centers.
