2971. BOARD OF STUDIES SUB-COMMITTEES

2972. NEW RESEARCH CENTRE PROPOSAL

(1) <u>Department for Health – Centre in Motivation and Health Behaviour</u> Change

Prof James Bilzon, Head of Department for Health, reported that this proposal would establish a strong, coherent Centre, based on the development of long-standing expertise and critical mass within the Department. This was an increasingly important area in Health for the Government and sent a signal both inside and outside the University that this was an area of significant growth and expertise. Prof Bilzon noted this area of research attracted significant grant income, and resulted in large numbers of publications and strong impact.

The Board felt that there was expertise in this area, particularly in the Department of Economics (and also the Department of Pharmacy and Pharmacology) which was not currently reflected in the paperwork and Prof Martyn Standage would be asked to amend the proposal to include reference to these links. Dr John Troyer noted that the Centre for Death and Society would welcome links with this new Centre.

The Board approved the establishment of a Centre in Motivation and Health Behaviour Change in the Department for Health on the recommendation of the Faculty Research Committee, subject to Prof Standage exploring and including links with the Department of Economics (paper 80).

(2) Department of Social and Policy Sciences

Dr Joe Devine, Head of Department for Social and Policy Sciences, reported that the Centre had been successful in terms of income generation and the number of publications it had been involved in. The challenge for the Centre over the next three years would be to explore the boundaries and synergies that existed with the Institute for Policy Research.

The Board approved the recommendation from the Faculty Research Committee that the Centre for the Analysis of Social Policy continue for a further three years following its recent review (paper 81).
