### iTrent in-semester annual leave for staff in academic grades:

When staff in the academic grades (i.e. from Lecturer through to Professor) request annual leave they will need to select whether their requested leave is in an in-semester or out-of-semester period. This determines if authorisation is required (it is required for leave during the in-semester period but not during the out-of-semester period).

The in-semester period is defined as the periods shown in the chart above with a white background - i.e. those marked with S (Study days), R/A and [A] days (Revision and assessment days), and W (Welcome activities for new students).
