

The Chancellors' Building Audio Visual Facilities User Guide

The audio visual provision in the Chancellors' Building uses university standard equipment and will have the same layout and functionality as other general teaching rooms (GTA) on campus.



Equipment list:

- Projector(s) & screen
- PC – Requires university user account
- Connections for devices using VGA and HDMI connections (please bring any adapters supplied with you portable device)
- Whiteboards (**not available** in the 350 seat theatres 1.10 & 1.11. The visualisers must be used)
- Visualiser – **Note: Paper and pens or prepared notes will be required.**
No visualiser provision in Group Rooms 4.6, 4.7, 4.9, 4.16, 5.12 & PC labs 4.17, 5.13



- Microphones – fixed and wearable (The wearable mics will automatically switch on when lifted from the charging cradle. Please return after use)
- Blu-Ray/DVD player
- Lecture capture recording is available on request.

(Note: all rooms include capture cameras and visualiser recording)
- Battery charging zone at the rear of the room for laptops, phones etc.


Rooms: CB 3.6, 3.7, 3.10, 3.11, 3.15, 3.16, 4.5, 4.6, 4.7, 4.8, 4.9, 4.10, 4.16, 5.5, 5.6, 5.7, 5.8, 5.12

Furniture layouts are a mix of standard rows and group working desks.

Presentation is via a single projector with an electric screen and whiteboards.



The touch panel for AV control is situated on the lectern

Press the On button  then choose your source to activate the system.



The image above shows the lighting and electric screen controls.

Press the  button to show/hide these.

The visualiser is located in the ceiling above the lectern. The zoom/focus controls will be displayed on the touch panel when this source is selected.

Rooms: CB 1.12, 2.6, 3.1, 3.5, 3.9, 4.1, 5.1

Furniture layouts are a mix of standard rows and tiered seating.

Presentation is via dual projectors with column whiteboards and screens.



The AV touch panel operation is as before.

The dual projectors can display the same or two different sources.



Rooms: 4.17 PClab, 5.13 PC lab

AV Control is as for the dual projector rooms above.

Rooms: CB 1.10, 1.11

Large tiered lecture theatre.

Presentation is via either single or dual projectors.



Important Note: No whiteboards are available, as the rooms are too large.



Dual visualisers have been provided on the teaching desk, so **paper and pens or prepared notes will be required.**

The AV touch panel operation is as before.

In addition there are VGA & HDMI sources from the separate 'VariHite' lectern
