•	Monitoring, operating and reporting of environmental equipment, including air-conditioning, UPS', generator, dry cooler, fire alarm systems etc.	
•	Write and maintain operational procedures in Data Centre and similar areas.	
•	Perform PAT testing for Data Centre and Computing Services equipment	
•	Maintain full register of assets of servers and network equipment.	
•	Configure and install network switches in communications rooms both on-site and on our sites around Bath.
