

Transcript: How to search for a journal article using the Library Catalogue

In this short video, I will show you how to search for a journal article using the Library Catalogue.

Begin on the library home page. Click the 'sign in' option just below the catalogue search box to the left and middle of the screen.

Then, sign in to the catalogue. Following the basic instructions on the screen.

We're now in the library catalogue. For this example, I'm searching for the article 'Green Campus Infrastructure and Students' Mental Health'.

So in the search box I've entered the first few words of the title and the last name of one of the authors, Aashiq Khan, and then I click the search button.

The first result relates to the article we want, but if you can't find this, narrow down your results by clicking the articles filter just below the search box.

Back to the first result and note the 'full text available' button.

In some results, the button will have an alternative label such as 'View Online', 'Online Access' or 'Get PDF'. Let's click this button.

We have now entered the full catalogue record for this article, and we finally click the link provided under the heading 'Full Text Availability'.

We've now accessed the article on the journal website and note the link to the same article in PDF format.
