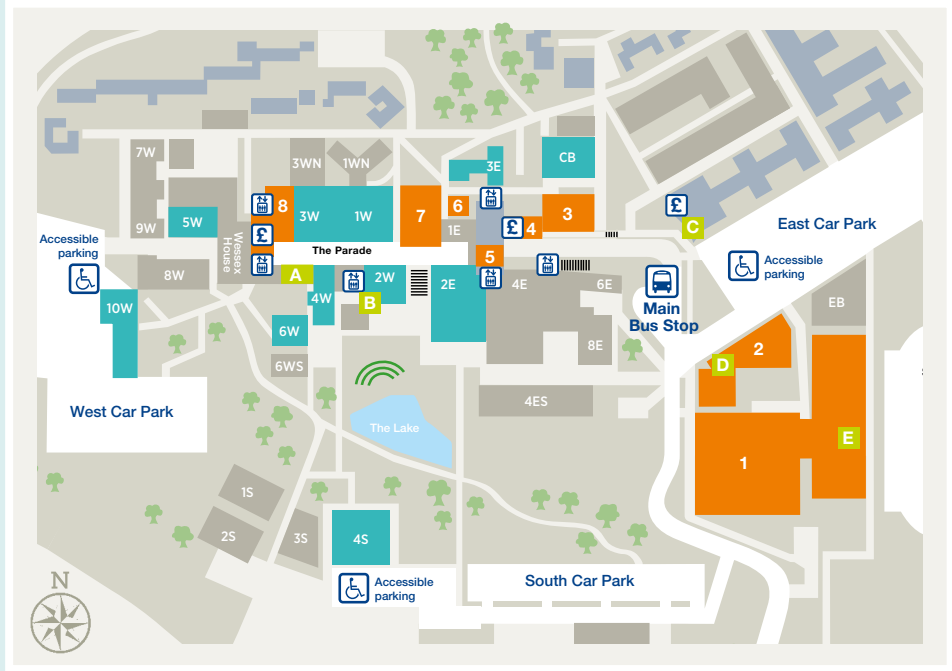
Library
