BRIEF OUTLINE OF THE CAREER OF DORA MATHISON

Louise Dora Mathison was born in 1907. She was educated privately and at Anstey Physical Training College, Birmingham, UK. After graduation she re-joined the College as a member of staff. She played hockey at county level for Dorset and at territorial level for the West and the Midlands. She was selected to represent her country, playing at left wing, as part of the All England Women's Hockey Association national team touring South Africa in 1930.

An all-round sportswoman Dora, whose married name was Carslaw, also played cricket, lacrosse and tennis to a high standard. She was qualified as a hockey umpire and towards the end of her career was employed as a tennis, hockey and swimming coach at Millfield School, Somerset, UK.

DESCRIPTION OF THE COLLECTION

The material is presented in the order given in the contents list. It dates from c 1924 to 1965 and mainly comprises material assembled by Dora Mathison during the Women's Empire Hockey Tournament in South Africa.

This section contains a small amount of memorabilia assembled by Dora Mathison. It relates mainly to her visit to South Africa as a member of the All England Women's Hockey Association touring team that participated in the Women's Empire Hockey Tournament, between June and October 1930. It also includes photographs relating to her time as a student at Anstey College of Physical Education in Birmingham and her later work in Malaysia and Singapore coaching women's hockey.
