Project A - Resources for University Task & Finish and Working Groups (sub UEB)

Project A will give the successful intern an opportunity to take on their first professional role and develop experience in stakeholder engagement, data collection and analysis, problem-solving, report writing, presentation skills, and to develop some project management skills.

Project B - The development of a Council Member Induction Toolkit

This project will include benchmarking of other institutions' provision, a gap analysis of existing Bath materials, and the creation of concise, accessible guidance for new members across our governance structures.

The project will facilitate the development of stakeholder engagement, research, drafting and structured project delivery skills.

What you'll do:

 Liaise with stakeholders to map existing documentation for task and finish groups

- Develop an ontology of resource types (e.g., agendas, minutes, reports)
- Analyse findings and produce a short report with recommendations
- Present your recommendations to senior leaders, including the Deputy Vice-Chancellor and Provost
- Help create resources and a communications plan for rollout
- Benchmark other universities' induction materials and develop a Council
 Member Induction Toolkit
