

Bath Insights Internship – Student Leader Training Hub Redevelopment

Department: Students' Union (Peer Support)

Theme: Operations

About the role:

Within the Peer Support Team, the Skills and Development Manager will be implementing a project in 2026 to focus on the re-development of a Student Leader Online Training Hub. A Student Leader is anyone who takes on a voluntary role in the SU, including exec members, committee members, peer mentors, academic reps, freshers' captains, and student trainers. While in post, Student Leaders are required to complete compulsory training for their roles, as well as having the opportunity to voluntarily upskill themselves through a series of workshops, either online or in person. The Skills and Development Manager is currently in the planning stage for redesigning the Student Leader Online Hub, which will require transferring some of the current training modules onto an alternative platform, and re-organising this ready for Student Leaders in the Academic Year 2026-2027.

The internship will centre on evaluating and redeveloping the current Student Leader Training Hub, which serves over 2,500 Student Leaders. This will involve researching how Student Leaders engage with both online and in-person training, working closely with the training teams, and analysing data from existing platforms to understand usage and areas for improvement.

The findings will inform a written evaluation report, including data-driven recommendations for the future design of the Online Student Leader Training Hub. While the full redevelopment is a long-term initiative, incoming Student Leaders will still require immediate access to compulsory training. Therefore, part of the internship will involve transferring existing training modules to a new platform and redesigning them to be accessible and user-friendly. This aspect of the role will require confidence in web design, video editing, and animation, and will involve collaborating with the Skills and Development Manager to identify priority areas for the next academic year.

- Analyse data from existing platforms to identify usage trends and areas for improvement

- Produce a written evaluation report with data-driven recommendations for redesigning the Online Training Hub
- Transfer existing training modules to a new platform and redesign them for better accessibility and usability
- Collaborate with the Skills and Development Manager to prioritise updates for the next academic year
- Use web design, video editing, and animation skills to create engaging training content
