The University of Bath's International Relations Office have launched the Go Abroad Bursary Scheme which gives under represented students the opportunity to attend a summer school abroad.

Summer Schools are short-term immersive packages that combine subject-specific tuition and social activities.

They are a fantastic opportunity to gain specialist knowledge in a range of topics, grow confidence and experience a new culture without having to commit to a full semester or year abroad. They also increase international competence (the ability to confidently be able to communicate with people from other cultures) which is highly valued by employers.




