

University of Bath Intellectual Property Protection Process Overview

- IP protection should be considered where research outcomes, inventions or ideas produced by University staff and/or researchers ;
 - Have potential for wider external application.
 - Could generate financial value in excess of cost of protection from licensing, sale or other mechanisms.
- Protectable ideas and inventions can arise from any discipline including engineering, physical sciences, education, social sciences etc.
