Latest News

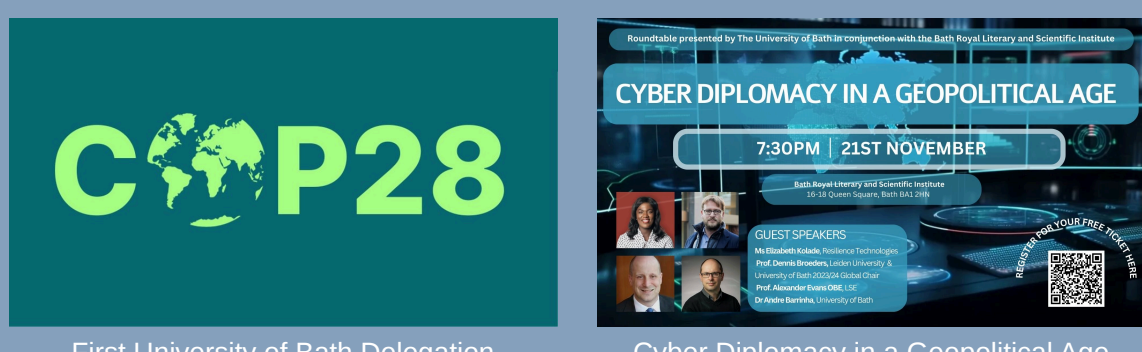

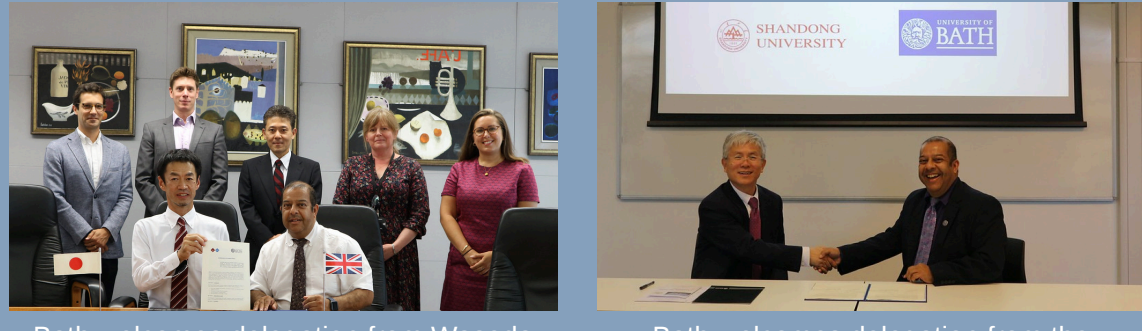

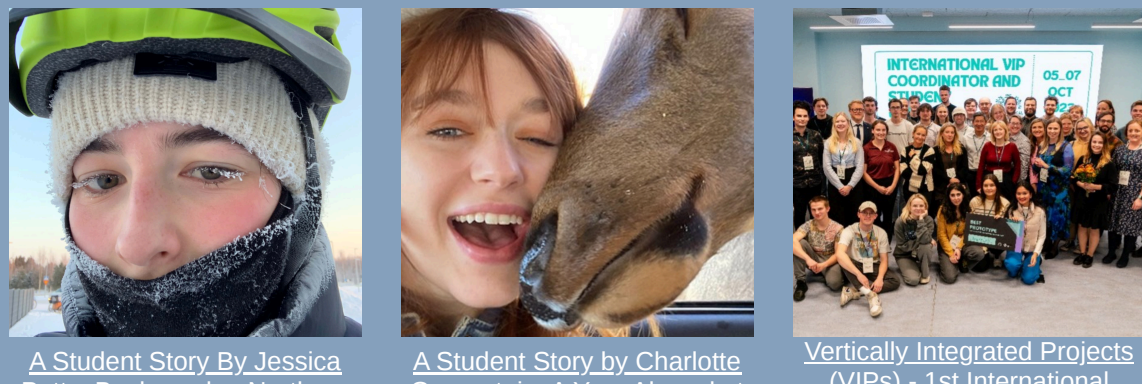
