| Essential Criteria   |
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| 1. About the engagee and work  |
| 1.1 Sole Trader, Individual or Ltd Company   |
| 1.2 Work has not started   |
| 1.3 The engagee/worker will not be an "office holder" i.e board member, treasure, trustee, company secretary or director   |
| 1.4 The UoB would accept a substitute who is equally qualified if the engagee/worker is unable to perform all or some of the work (the UoB would pay the engagee and the engagee would pay the substitute) |
| 2. Working Arrangements  |
| 2.1 The engagee cannot be moved onto a different task (this would require a new assessment and contract)   |
| 2.2 The working hours will be based on agreed deadlines (UoB cannot solely decide without agreement from engagee/worker)   |
| 2.3 The location of where the work is carried out will be determined by the task   |

| 3.1 The engagee/worker will not need to buy any equipment or materials to perform this work (does not include laptops, tablets and phones)       |

| 4.1 The engagee/worker will be paid a fixed price for the project or be paid an hourly/daily/weekly rate   |
| 4.2 If the work is not satisfactory, the engagee/worker would still be paid because the work is time specific/for a single event                 |
| 4.3 The engagee/worker will not receive any corporate benefits (including parking)   |
| 5. Engagee/worker contracts  |
| 5.1 You know the name of the engagee/worker providing the service  |
| 5.2 The engagee/worker will be free to undertake other work for similar organisations and does not need permission from UoB to do so             |
| 5.3 If the engagee/worker has had previous contracts with UoB, there must be a gap between the previous engagement ending and this one beginning |
| 5.4 This engagement will not take up the majority of the engagee/worker's available working time   |
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
