

This video shows you how to search for an e-journal using the Library Catalogue.

In this example, I will search for the journal called 'Harvard Business Review'. Enter the title into the search box and then click on 'search'.

The journal that you're looking for will usually appear near the top of the results list.

To limit your search just to journals, you can choose 'journals' from the drop down menu.

Now Harvard Business Review appears first in the list.

The 'online access' link tells you that we provide this journal in online format. Click the link to view the journal online.

We buy journals from a range of suppliers so the options for viewing and using them will vary. This particular journal is from EBSCO's Business Source Complete database.

Click the link to EBSCO

You can browse the contents using the years shown on the right-hand side and you can also opt to search within the publication here. Click on a given year to see the individual issues of a journal.

Once you have selected a particular issue you will then be able to see the individual articles. Click on the PDF link or HTML to view the article in full.

When you have finished reading, to return to the list of dates, use the back button on the browser and then you're ready to browse another issue or search within the publication.
