


Submitting an upload near the end of the exam window

As long as the upload begins and you **do not** close the browser window, your upload should complete and your submission will be saved, even if it doesn't complete until after the exam window has officially closed. If it is still uploading when you are timed out, you will see a similar screen to the image below.

Note that the time remaining is 0:00, and it says "Timed out!" in the top left of the screen but the upload still has an estimated 6 seconds left.



Your submission will still upload.

However, closing the browser **will stop the upload**, and the file will not be uploaded. You will typically have to close a browser pop-up asking you to confirm you want to leave the page when you try to close it mid-upload.

In the case of the internet connection dropping during the upload, the file should continue to upload once the internet connection has been restored. However, please be aware it can take some time to restart the upload (sometimes more than 5 minutes after the connection has been restored).

What happens if you want to replace a submission?

If you upload a file, that file will remain in Inspira and will not be replaced unless a valid file is uploaded to replace it.

So, for the following scenarios, where you have already uploaded a file:

- If you click replace, and let it fully upload (even if that upload finishes after the end of the exam), the file will be replaced.
- If you click replace, but don't select a file, the original will still be there.
- If you click replace, start uploading a file, and don't let it finish uploading, the original will still be there.
