# Part I Business

### **ACTION**

#### 351 **Declarations of Interest**

# 356 Annual report on errors in examination papers from 2023/24

The Board considered a report on examination paper errors from the 2023/24 session (Paper SM24/25-032). The report lists 4 papers with errors which is about 2% of all examination papers written within the School.

Members noted that the errors were mainly caused by on-line (Inspera) examinations and that the School will not be running examinations under that method of delivery in 2024/25.

Members noted that the boards considered units that were in the atypical range but only scaled units on an exceptional basis based on evidence which indicated scaling was appropriate.

The Director for Postgraduate Teaching noted the discussions that had taken place prior to boards to ensure that markers had been clear on the new pass mark of 50, and the implications of this for expected means.
