Students' Union

Visit our Students' Union which is based in both the main Student Centre (grid ref: D4) and The Edge (grid ref: E3) on campus. The SU has an award winning Bar and Nightclub, The Plug and The Tub. You can enjoy a range of hot and cold drinks and a delicious menu with consistently low prices!

Study

Our 24-hour library (grid ref: D4), at the heart of the campus, provides a huge range of electronic and print resources, with enquiry support and subject specialists on each of the upper floors, and a variety of study spaces for group and individual work. With lots of PCs and wireless networking throughout, students can find a place to study that suits them. There are additional independent learning spaces on campus and in the city.

Sports

Our inspirational Sports Training Village, home to Olympic and Paralympic Champions, is also fully open to the public - check out our gym and fitness classes, 50m swimming pool, indoor and outdoor tennis courts and athletics track. (Grid ref: E3)

Arts

Pop in and check out our arts building 'The Edge' (grid ref: E3) which has a double height gallery space, 220 seat theatre, studio theatre, and dance and music studios! The Edge is part of the Students' Union and is a student-dedicated space for arts, wellbeing, creative and social activities. If you are lucky, you may see one of our SU groups in action running through a rehearsal for a stage show!

Campus

We are one of the safest campus sites in the UK and the first university in the country to win a national police-approved security award. Our campus is nestled in beautiful woodlands, and is not far from the hidden gem Sham Castle on the Bath Skyline walk - perfect for quiet escape: www.nationaltrust.org.uk/bath-skyline

Just hop on the bus (Bath UniBus U1) to get into the city centre within ten minutes, or grab a taxi at the taxi rank (grid reference: E3).

Or you can take a 30 minute walk down Bathwick Hill, with gorgeous views of Bath's famous Georgian terraces. Once you're at the bottom of the hill, turn left onto Pulteney Road and then right onto North Parade.

Uni in the City

Visit the Virgil Building, our city centre student hub. It offers independent and group study space and a Student Support centre. Get the bus down to the train station then head up Manvers Street - it's on the right, you can't miss it!

Discover the city

Bath is the UK's only entire city designated a UNESCO World Heritage site, so take some time to wander the lanes to discover its beautiful stone buildings and independent shops, as well as the Southgate shopping centre. In addition to the famous Roman Baths, the city is also host to many museums, galleries, restaurants, cafés and live music bars. You could also spend a relaxing afternoon in the thermae spa or simply take a long lunch on the banks of the River Avon.

Campus Map

Self-guided Tour

Use this tour to explore our campus at your own pace. It takes you through the heart of the campus and you will see a variety of our student accommodation options and academic departments. If you need any help with directions please visit the reception desk in the Library. (Follow the footprints on the map).

1. Start your tour at the main University bus stop.

E3
2. Walk up the steps / take the lift to the Parade. On your right you'll see our Student Centre, home to the Students' Union offices, The Plug Bar and The Tub Nightclub. This building is open 8am til late, so you can pop in and see our award winning SU.

D3
3. Continue along the Parade to the library, the centre of the campus. You are very welcome to look around any day, except during our exam periods of January and May.

D4
4. Cross the Parade and go down the steps opposite the Library / take the lift between 2W and 4W to see the lake. This is a great spot to relax and eat your lunch if the weather is good! You can also access the Fountain Canteen from here.

D3
5. Go back up the steps / use the lift and turn left down the Parade and you'll come to 4W which houses our Student Support Centre and then the 4W Café. Ahead at Wessex House you will see our Careers Centre and on the right-hand side our campus supermarket and post office.

C3
6. Continue straight ahead down the walk way until you reach 10W, our home for Psychology. Feel free to take a look inside. Across the car park you can see Polden Corner which includes our Polden accommodation and our West Accommodation Centre.

7. Follow the road uphill past 9W and 7W to the end of the road, turn right and walk up the road to see some of our student accommodation.

D4
8. Turn right at the no entry sign to visit the Chancellors' Building and take a look at some of the teaching spaces on offer.

E4
9. Re-join the road and then Eastwood is on your left. Continue along the road and turn right. Woodland Court is on your left.

10. Continue along to our student accommodation, The Quads. 708 en-suite rooms across five buildings make up this part catered complex.

11. Turn back towards the road, before turning left to follow the path between The Quads and Solsbury Court.

12. Turn left around the Lime Tree. Continue straight ahead, past the East Car Park towards The Edge, our arts building.

13. Continue around the corner and you will find the Sports Training Village with its fantastic facilities including the Olympic length swimming pool and the Team Bath Gym and Fitness Centre. You will see the new School of Management facing the Sports Training Village.
