



## **Sponsor Conditions**

If you have an external sponsor to help fund your postgraduate study it may bring potential benefits, such as exposure to 'frontline' research and an opportunity to build connections with an organisation you might be interested in working for in the future. However, it is important to note that this may bring with it possible commercial sensitivities, meaning that sponsor may wish to place certain restrictions on disclosure of your research outputs. For example, they may require a delay on publication of your results and/or, if your thesis contains commercially sensitive information, that it be placed in the University's library under 'restricted access' status for a prescribed period of time. These requirements are not considered unusual or unreasonable and will *not* affect whether or not you achieve the award of a postgraduate degree.

So, once you are at the University, you may need to sign a short statement confirming that you will treat sensitive information you receive or develop in the course of your postgraduate study properly and professionally and that you will adhere to restrictions on disclosure and use requested of you by the University. Your Supervisor at the University will let you know if and when this is required.

If you register as a student with the University of Bath you will be required to agree to abide by the University's Intellectual Property Policy.
