Students counted

The tables here summarise the numbers of students studying at, or in association with, the University of Bath in the academic year 2015/16 at the snapshot date of 1 December 2015. It is at this date that early returns from Universities are made to the Higher Education Funding Councils. The overall total of students given in these tables (16820) is the number of those with active registrations at the census date; it excludes all students whose registration was in suspense, and those research students who, having completed their research, were writing-up their theses either with reduced supervision or without supervision.

Student types

Three types of students are included: *core*, *staff* and *visiting*. Visiting students are incoming students on exchange programmes such as the EU SOCRATES-ERASMUS programme, or students on programmes jointly run with other universities who are studying at Bath but do not intend to gain an award from the University of Bath. Staff are those full-time staff of the University of Bath who are also registered as part-time students. All others are core students.

Levels

Two levels are included: *undergraduate* (taught programmes only, Foundation Degree/sub-degree, and degree, including undergraduate Masters such as MEng) and *postgraduate*. Postgraduate includes both *taught* and *research*.

Mode of study

Students are divided into two modes of study: *Full-time*, including programmes with a sandwich placement, and *Part-time*, including distance learning.

Fee status

Tuition fees are charged at two different rates: *home* and *overseas*. UK and EU students are eligible to pay home fees. All other students pay overseas fees. Seventy two students domiciled in the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man, are included in the overseas category, to comply with the practice of the Higher Education Funding Council for England (HEFCE).

International students

The table of international student numbers shows students whose *nationality* is other than British and students whose *domicile* is other than UK. This analysis assumes that the students from the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man and any student whose nationality is not known are not international students. The table includes all types of active registrations: core, visiting students and staff registrations. The table lists those countries with the most students at the University of Bath arranged in descending order by domicile. Domicile is the country of the student's permanent or home address immediately preceding the start of their programme of study. Within the total international student numbers, 127 domicile countries and 137 nationality countries are represented. About 2% of the international students are based off campus, primarily on distance learning programmes.

Faculties & departments

Programmes are generally located within Departments; and Departments generally within Faculties. Some programmes are shared between Departments, or between Faculties - these are shown as cross-department or cross-faculty programmes. These Departmental analyses include all types of active registrations, including visiting students and staff registrations. There are four Faculty-level bodies within the University: the Faculty of Engineering & Design, the Faculty of Humanities & Social Sciences, the School of Management and the Faculty of

Science. Sub-totals are shown for each Faculty and include their own cross-department programmes; cross-faculty programmes are shown below the Faculty sub-totals.

Study at other locations & Foundation Degree/sub-degree study

The undergraduate category includes 194 students on Foundation Degree/sub-degree/honours year programmes in local partner colleges in the region and the University's Bath campus. These students appear in the Faculty/Department totals according to their administrative locations within the University.
