Disability by Fee Status



EXPLANATORY NOTES



Students counted

The tables here summarise the numbers of students studying at, or in association with, the University of Bath in the academic year 2024/25 at the snapshot date of 1 December 2024. It is at this date that early returns from Universities are made to the Higher Education Funding Councils. The overall total of students given in these tables (21,685) is the number of those with active registrations at the census date; it excludes all students whose registration was in suspense, and those research students who, having completed their research, were writing-up their theses either with reduced supervision or without supervision.

Student types

Two types of students are included: core and visiting. Visiting students are incoming students on exchange programmes such as the EU SOCRATES-ERASMUS programme, or students on programmes jointly run with other universities who are studying at Bath but do not intend to gain an award from the University of Bath.

Most tables exclude visiting students and only show core active students whose numbers total 21,340.

Levels

Three levels are included: undergraduate (taught programmes only, Foundation Degree/sub-degree, and degree, including undergraduate Masters such as MEng), postgraduate taught and research.

Mode of study

Students are divided into two modes of study: Full-time, including programmes with a sandwich placement, and Part-time, including distance learning.

Fee eligibility status

Tuition fees are charged at two different rates: Home and Overseas. From 2021/22 onwards those eligible for Home fees include UK students and those domiciled in the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man (who are referred to as Island students). All other students, including those from the EU, must pay Overseas fees.

Prior to 2021/22, both UK and EU students were eligible to pay Home fees but Island students were not eligible for Home fees. All students from outside the UK and EU, including Island students, were required to pay Overseas fees.

Faculties

There are four Faculty-level bodies within the University: the Faculty of Engineering & Design, the Faculty of Humanities & Social Sciences, the School of Management and the Faculty of Science. Some courses are multi disciplinary with two different Faculties being involved in delivering the course, these are categorised as Cross-faculty programmes and shown as a separate category in the Faculty tables.

Foundation Degree, sub-degree and honours year study

The figures include students on Foundation Degree/sub-degree/honours year programmes at the University's Bath campus and in local partner colleges in the region. These students are categorised as Undergraduates and appear in the Faculty totals according to their administrative locations within the University.

Data suppression

All data is rounded to the nearest 5 students or supressed to 0 f the count of students drops below 2.5. All percentages are derived from rounded data and therefore may not sum to 100% dependant on the rounding of the categories within the percentage calculation.

BAME terminology

We recognise the diversity of individual identities and lived experiences, and we also recognise that BAME is an imperfect term. The University is in the process of releasing guidance on replacing the terminology, once released this report will be updated.
