




A guide to applying for a Student Visa - Overseas

All prospective international students coming to study in the UK for a course lasting more than 6 months, including those from the EU, EEA (except Ireland) and Switzerland who have not secured other immigration status, need to obtain a Student visa before they arrive in the UK to study. If you do need to apply for a Student visa and you are not already in the UK, you must submit an online application via this <u>link</u>.

Click **Apply now** to begin the application:




To begin, you will need to select **where you are planning to live in the UK**. This will most likely be the first option if you are coming to study at The University of Bath.



You will then need to choose which **type of passport** you are planning to use for your Student visa application. If you select '**yes**' to the EU, EEA or Swiss passport question, you will then be taken through a series of screens in which you will be asked to set up a UKVI account. You will be given more information on how to download the <u>UK Immigration: ID check app</u> which you will use to upload your biometric information instead of having to attend a biometric appointment at a Visa Application Centre. Once you have created your UKVI account, you will be able to proceed with the rest of the application, please continue to read this guide from page 5. Otherwise, if you do not hold a passport from one of these countries, please select '**no**' and proceed to the next step.








Once you provided these details, you will need to confirm if you have been awarded a Fulbright, Marshall, Chevening or Commonwealth scholarship.

You will be asked about your **spoken language preference** in the eventuality that UKVI need to contact you about your application. It is advisable to select English as your answer.



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

As you will only have a maximum 30-day travel window before your course starts, you should aim to arrive **within 1 month** of your course start date.



Once you reach this section, you should be ready to **make the payment** for the Immigration Health Surcharge and the Student visa application. You will then have the chance to book your **biometric appointment** at your chosen visa application centre.
