

Guaranteed Conditional Offers for International Summer School Participants 2026:

Terms and Conditions

The University of Bath is committed to ensuring that all students with an offer to study at Bath are academically prepared and are able to enjoy and succeed on their chosen degree course. As such, the criteria below are to help clarify the conditions on which we are able to issue a guaranteed conditional offer.

In order to be eligible for a guaranteed conditional offer to the University of Bath, you must successfully complete all tasks within the programme and meet the following criteria:

- you will be applying for a university course that starts in September 2027
- a UCAS application is submitted by the UCAS 'on time' deadline for the next entry cycle
- you will complete all sections of the UCAS form including the personal statement for the degree you wish to study at Bath
- you will be applying to university as an international student ([classified by Overseas fee status](#))

Academic criteria

- You meet the 'essential' academic entry requirements for your chosen course as stated on our [course pages](#)
- You apply for an eligible course* for the subject area you undertook as part of the International Summer School
- You must be studying towards a qualification that is accepted as academically equivalent to level 3 study in the UK.
- You must meet the 'entry requirements' for the course you have applied for, as specified on our course pages and in tables 1 and 2 below.
- For all applicants, some courses also require other specific minimum requirements before an offer can be made (see Table 2 below).

Further eligibility

This programme is intended for international students only. The guaranteed conditional offer from this programme is contingent upon your fee status being formally determined as 'overseas' and upon successful completion of all associated tasks. The participation fee is non-refundable should you subsequently be assessed as having 'home' fee status during the formal UCAS admissions process.
