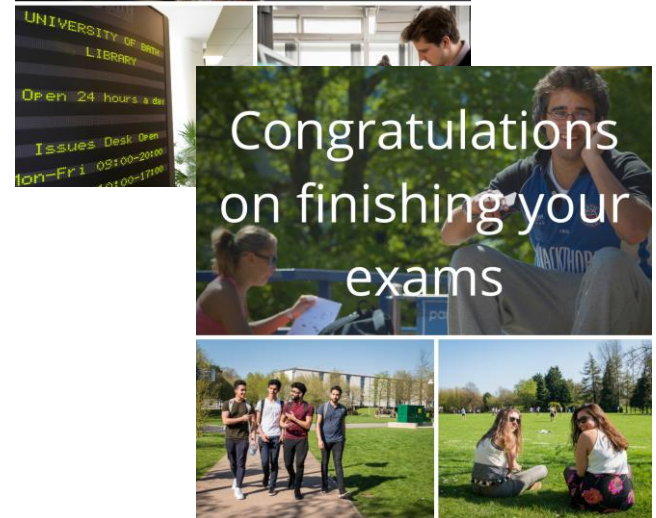
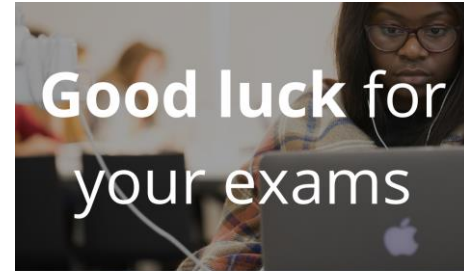


Winter Assessments
