## Eligibility

To be eligible for an Arts Scholarship, you must:

- Be a full-time undergraduate student studying at the University of Bath Claverton Down campus in the academic year 2026-7
- Not be on a part- or full-time placement year in the academic year 2026-7
- Not be a previous recipient of an Arts Scholarship award

## Funding and payment of awards

Arts Scholars receive a £1000 grant. The grant will be paid in full by bank transfer after acceptance of the Arts Scholarship award alongside provision of relevant bank details.

## How and when to apply

You can apply for an Arts Scholarship through the online form accessed from the [Arts Scholarships webpages](#). You must have submitted your application by **midnight (GMT) on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2027** to be considered.

## Selection and allocation

If you are successful at being shortlisted, you will then be invited to **audition in the week commencing Monday 8<sup>th</sup> February 2027**. You must ensure that you are prepared and available to audition **in-person** at the time we offer during this week. Requests for alternative audition days or times unfortunately cannot be accommodated.

Successful applicants will be offered an Arts Scholarship following audition and must formally accept the Scholarship as directed.

Arts Scholarships are discretionary. This means that even if you meet all of the relevant criteria, you are not guaranteed to receive an award.

## Requirements of an Arts Scholar

- Scholars are expected to spend the funds on the development of their artistic skills and ambitions. This may include (but is not limited to) lessons, equipment, travel or entrance fees to exhibitions or competitions.
- It is expected that Scholars will continue to develop artistically during their time at the University of Bath.
- Scholars may be required to attend events where their benefactor (donor) or benefactor's representative may be present, if it takes place during the academic year.
- Your name, the name of your scholarship, and excerpts from your application, survey responses, and any reports or letters you provide may be used in online and print materials to promote and publicise the impact of our philanthropic scholarships. We will contact you before we use any material that could identify you as an individual.

- Scholars may be required to provide information about their progress, for example by writing blogs, providing photographs, or sending project/performance information to the Arts Scholarships team. This information may be used to promote Arts Scholarships by the University.
- Scholars may be required to complete forms for promotion, evaluation and monitoring purposes.
- All reports and feedback requests must be completed and returned by the appropriate deadline and all correspondence responded to in a timely manner to meet with the terms of the Scholarship.

## Suspension, withdrawal from studies or study deferral

If you suspend, defer or withdraw from your studies whilst in receipt of an Arts Scholarship, you must notify the Arts Scholarships team on [arts-scholarships@bath.ac.uk](mailto:arts-scholarships@bath.ac.uk).

## General Terms and Conditions

Scholarships are allocated for 2026-7 entry only.

Should any of the Terms & Conditions **not** be met by a Scholar, the University reserves the right to withdraw the Scholarship at any point within the academic year.
