### **№** Food and Drink

There will be a range of catering outlets open throughout the day offering everything from light



snacks to hot meals (please refer to our campus map and use the coordinates below to find their locations).

The shops on campus accept cash but not the catering outlets. Most major debit cards are accepted (not Amex).

4 West Café (C3) 08:00-16:00 - Perhaps the most 'coffee shop' setting on campus. You can also buy paninis, soup and jacket potatoes.

Fresh (C4) 07.30-19.00 on Friday and 08.00 - 17.00 on Saturday - The local supermarket on campus that has a large variety of groceries, an extensive range of global foods, bakery and a Post Office.

The Hut by the Lake (D3) 11.00-15.00 - Here you can find food and drink to take away. There will be a variety of other outdoor food stalls nearby on The Parade.

Lime Tree (F4) 08:00-19:00 - Lots of choice with a café, bar and several places to buy food. This includes pizzas and pasta, salad bowls and cooked dinners.

Parade (D3) 10:00-15:00 - Enjoy great views over the lake whilst tucking into hot lunches (including vegan food), salads, hot drinks and cakes.

Sports Café (F3) 08:00-16:00 on Friday and 08.00 -17.00 on Saturday - A café in the Sports Training Village. Choose from cooked breakfasts, a great selection of cold and hot food, including salads, pasta and jacket potatoes, as well as high protein snacks.

The Edge Café (E3) 08:00-15:00 - A café which also doubles up as a student study space. You can buy cold and hot drinks, alongside rolls, wraps and ciabattas.

The Market (D4) 09.00-17.00 - A small shop that's big on sustainability. The Market sells ethical and sustainable clothing, merchandise, food and drink.

Pavilion Café (E3) 08:00-16:00 - Located in 10 East. our School of Management building. This café offers hot drinks, cakes, breakfast baps, pastries, toasted ciabattas and hot lunches.

The Pitstop (D4) 08:00-15:30 - A café located in the Students' Union offering hot drinks, all day breakfasts, ciabattas, pasties and crépes.

The Plug (D4) 09:00-16:00 - Eat, Drink, Play at the Students' Union bar, Grab a coffee and a cake, or a cold drink, whilst enjoying a game of pool, darts or air hockey.
