Research questions

- + How do educators respond to complex, interrelated global social challenges, including gender-based violence, child-on-child harm, sexual and reproductive justice, and environmental justice?
- How do liminal education leaders facilitate policy transitions in these contentious policy areas?
- How can children and young people be protagonists in their own lives and contribute to and/or resist how schools shape experiences of (in)justice?

A new project in development

- + How do CSOs anticipate and create change through CSE in an increasingly restrictive global landscape for sexual and reproductive justice?
- + Secondary data analysis collaboration with AmplifyChange, a Bath-based NGO that funds over 250 locally-led CSE projects in the Global South
- + Develop a secure natural language processing (NLP) system to analyse application data
- + Co-create speculative future scenarios for CSE
