BRIEF OUTLINE OF THE CAREER OF IAN HAY DAVISON

Ian Hay Davison (IHD) was born in 1931. He attended Dulwich College and then the London School

of Economics before completing postgraduate studies in business administration and computer

 $technology \ at \ the \ University \ of \ Michigan, \ USA. \ On \ his \ return \ to \ the \ UK \ in \ 1958 \ he \ joined \ the \ accounting$

and public services firm Arthur Andersen & Co. His early interest in IT and its application to business

 $practice, particularly\ accounting,\ was\ put\ to\ use,\ and\ he\ developed\ considerable\ expertise\ in\ financial$

management standards, self-regulation and governance. In 1966 he became managing partner for the

London office, and in 1973 for the whole of the UK. He held the position until his resignation in early

1983.

While he was working at Arthur Andersen & Co IHD was involved in a number of high-profile projects,

including a protracted legal case relating to Delorean Motor Cars Limited and financial irregularities.

During this time he also served on a number of public enquiries, and as chairman of the Accounting

Standards Committee of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of England and Wales (ICAEW).

In late 1982 he was asked by the Governor of the Bank of England to consider undertaking the job of

reforming accounting and financial management practices at Lloyd's of London. He subsequently

became Chief Executive and Deputy Chairman of the organisation in early 1983, conducting

consultative reviews of management and decision-making structures, and introducing new processes

for improving accounting standards and self-regulation. IHD resigned from Lloyd's in February 1986. An account of his experiences, entitled A View from the Room: Lloyd's Change and Disclosure, was

published in 1987.

IHD's extensive and wide-ranging experience in the private sector followed including directorships of

The Independent, Cadbury Schweppes and Midland Bank, and as chairman of Storehouse (BHS,

Mothercare and Habitat), Credit Lyonnais Securities and McDonnell Douglas Information Systems. In

addition, his portfolio included appointments as director of the Royal Opera House, trustee of the

Victoria and Albert Museum, chairman of the Sadler's Wells Foundation and president of the National

Council for One Parent Families. He served on the Council of the ICAEW from 1982-2005.

IHD was awarded an honorary degree by the University of Bath in 1998, and later by the London

School of Economics and the Royal College of Art. He received a CBE in 2002. He died in September

2022.

DESCRIPTION OF THE COLLECTION

The material is presented in the order given in the contents list. It covers the period from 1957 to 2017.

As far as possible the arrangement of the Collection follows the original order imposed by IHD.

The Collection comprises a broad range of material, including reports and other official

 $communications, \ working \ papers, \ correspondence, \ notes \ and \ diaries, \ relating \ to \ IHD'S \ professional$

working life through five decades. In combination they form a record of his long, active and varied career from his early studies of the pioneering use of computers in business and his ground-breaking

work as Chief Executive at Lloyd's of London to his involvement in controversial legal proceedings and

his extensive portfolio of directorships across both public and private sectors.

Journal and newspaper articles, and other published writings evidence his contribution to the reform

of accounting practices and corporate self-governance, and the role he played in developing ideas

about financial regulation.

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SECTION A ARTHUR ANDERSEN & CO A/1-A/6

This section mainly contains material relating to lan Hay Davison (IHD)'s work for the American accounting and public services firm Arthur Anderson & Co. In 1958, when he returned to the UK from the USA, he approached Arthur Andersen & Co and was hired on a senior grade. He became a managing partner of the London office in 1966 and was promoted to managing partner for the whole of the UK in 1973. In 1983 he resigned from Arthur Andersen & Co to take up the post of Chief Executive of Lloyd's.

The section also contains a small amount of material relating to IHD's postgraduate studies at the University of Michigan, prior to his employment at Arthur Andersen & Co.

The arrangement and ordering of the material preserve as far as possible the filing system used by IHD.

Established in 1973, the Price Commission was responsible for administering the Price Code under the Counter Inflation Act, and for advising the Secretary of State for Prices and Consumer Protection on prices and charges. This included the vetting of submissions for price increases, investigation of variations and alleged breaches of the code, and monitoring of retail food prices. The abolition of the Price Commission was announced in 1979 and it was wound up in the following year under the Competition Act 1980.

IHD served as a member of the Price Commission from 1977 to 1979. During this time he was involved in several Commission enquiries. The biggest of these was the enquiry into bank charges which started in September 1977 and finished in March 1978.
