EVERYTHING YOU NEED

Our rent is all-inclusive, meaning that all your utility bills are covered by one regular payment – including fast WiFi. We have accommodation in the city and on campus, with great transport links between. Most of our students live in houses or flats with bedrooms grouped around communal kitchens or social spaces. You can also apply to live in accommodation with Eat and Drink credit to use in our food and drink outlets on campus.

FINDING THE RIGHT HOME

We're committed to providing a safe and happy environment for you to live in. We value diversity and inclusivity and want everyone to be treated with respect. If you're an eligible first-year undergraduate, you can tell us if you'd prefer to live in accommodation that's designated as:



If you have a diagnosed medical or mental health condition, or a disability that will have an impact your accommodation choices, our team will work with you to assess your requirements and find you a suitable room.

If you identify as transitioning gender we may be able to place you in an ensuite bedroom or a studio.

If you identify as non-binary or intersex as we can look at allocating you to a mixed-gender flat.



FAQs

AM I GUARANTEED ACCOMMODATION?

We guarantee accommodation to all our first-year full-time undergraduate students if:

- you receive an offer to study and make us your firm choice institution
- we receive your application for accommodation before the deadline of 1 July

Care Leavers, refugees, former Foyer residents, and estranged students are guaranteed a place in

university accommodation for 365 days a year for the duration of your course.

WHAT IF I HAVE AN INSURANCE OFFER OR PLACE THROUGH CLEARING?

Applications for waiting list accommodation open again on 20 August. A space in our accommodation is not guaranteed but we will make every effort to find you a place.

WHEN DO I NEED TO APPLY?

Once you've Bath as your firm choice, you will then be able to apply for accommodation. Applications open 8 May with the deadline for guaranteed accommodation 1 July.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER MY FIRST YEAR?

Students live in private sector housing after their first year. Our private sector housing service can support with this, offering advice and signposting accommodation options.

WHAT IS EAT AND DRINK CREDIT?

Eat and Drink credit is added from your accommodation fees into your Eat and Drink account. The amount of credit you get depends on where you live. You use your library card or BathGo app to use credit to buy food and drink in the campus outlets whenever you choose, or purchase from The Market to cook at home. You receive a 10% discount on food and drink purchases (excluding The Market).
