Undergraduate Finalist	
Degree awarded	
P-AWD_DAP P-AWD_NONDAP P-AWD_MIT	You have met your programme's requirements for an award and the Board of Studies have awarded you a degree.
P-AWD_TT_HON	You are no longer eligible to continue with/exit with an award on your current course of study. The Board of Studies have awarded you an alternative Honours degree.
P-COM	Programme of study is complete.

P-GRD_1	You have met your programme's requirements for an award and the Board of Studies have awarded you a degree with First Class Honours
P-GRD_2.1	You have met your programme's requirements for an award and the Board of Studies have awarded you a degree with Upper Second Class honours
P-GRD_2.2	You have met your programme's requirements for an award and the Board of Studies have awarded you a degree with Lower Second Class honours
P-GRD_3	You have met your programme's requirements for an award and the Board of Studies have awarded you a degree with Third Class honours
P-GRD_A	The Board of Studies have awarded you an Aegrotat Degree (without classification)
P-GRD_TTHECE	You have not met the requirements for the undergraduate degree but have been awarded a Certificate of Higher Education
P-GRD_TTHEDI	You have not met the requirements for the undergraduate degree but have been awarded a Diploma of Higher Education
P-GRD_UN	You have met your programme's requirements for an award and the Board of Studies have awarded you a degree with unclassified honours.

### Degree not awarded (alternative options if possible)

D-YNC D-YNC_S2	The Board of Examiners for Programmes has not yet recommended a decision to the Board of Studies because you have not undertaken all your units for this stage.
F-AWD F-AWD_DAP F-AWD-NONDAP	You have not passed your programme of study or achieved an award.
R-RDS_F	You have not passed this stage and therefore have not yet met the requirements for your award. Further assessment is required to be eligible for an award.

### Undergraduate Non-Finalist (Progression)

#### Able to progress to next stage

C-CS C-CS_S1	You have not yet reached a point in your programme where a progression or award decision is made, continue with your studies.
P-CON P-CON_S1	You have passed your current stage and will progress to the next stage of your programme.  You have failed some units, but as the results were within the condonable range (unit mark of 35-39%) the Board has agreed these can be condoned and you have been awarded the credit for them. You are not required to do any re-assessment.
P-PGS P-PGS_S1	You have passed your current stage and can now progress to the next stage of study.
P-RDS_CP_1	You can progress to the next stage of your programme but you also need to do re-assessment in all the units you have failed this year.
P-RPT_EOP	You can progress to the next stage of your programme but you will need to repeat the units you failed in a supplementary stage at the end of your programme.
P-SUP_STG	You have reached the end of your programme of study and must now repeat the units you have failed in a supplementary stage.
P-TTDP	You have passed the re-assessment required to transfer from your current programme to the next stage on the Designated Alternative Programme (DAP). You will be transferred automatically.
P-TTDP_CP_1	You have passed the re-assessment required to transfer from your current programme to the next stage on the Designated Alternative Programme (DAP). You will be transferred automatically. You also have outstanding reassessment to complete from a previous stage.
P-TTH	You may progress from the Foundation programme onto the honours programme.

#### Unable to Progress and, where applicable, further action required

<b>A-CPTYR</b> <b>A-CPTSEM</b> <b>A-CPTS2</b>	You are in a period of absence, no Board of Examiners decision is required.
<b>D-YNC_S2</b>	The Board of Examiners for Programmes has not yet recommended an end of stage decision to the Board of Studies because you have not undertaken all your units for this stage.
<b>F-RPT_EOS</b>	<b>Foundation Year only.</b> You have not passed this stage and are now required to retake the units you failed during the next academic year in order to progress.
<b>F-RPTST</b>	You have not passed this stage and are required to repeat this stage during the next academic year in order to progress.
<b>F-RPT_SUP</b>	You have not passed this stage and are required to retake failed units in a supplementary stage in order to progress.
<b>F-RPTST_M</b>	You have not passed this stage and are required to repeat this stage during the next academic year in order to progress. Due to accepted mitigating circumstances the stage may be repeated as if for the first attempt.
<b>F-TTDP</b> <b>F-TTDP_S1</b>	You have not passed this stage and cannot continue on the programme you are currently on.  You are required to transfer from your current programme to the Designated Alternative Programme (DAP) and will be transferred automatically.
<b>F-TTDP_RPTST</b>	You have not passed this stage and cannot progress to the next stage of the programme you are currently on. However, you have a choice about your next steps and you can either:  1) transfer from your current programme to the Designated Alternative Programme (DAP) and progress to the next stage (of the DAP),  OR,  2) repeat the stage you have just completed.
<b>F-TTDP_WD</b>	You have not passed this stage and cannot continue on the programme you are currently on. You have a choice about your next steps, you can either:  1) withdraw from the programme,  OR,  2) progress to the next stage on the Designated Alternative Programme (DAP).
<b>F-TTDP+RPTST</b>	You have not passed this stage and cannot continue with the programme you are currently on.  You will be transferred from your current programme to the Designated Alternative Programme (DAP) <b>AND</b> be required to repeat the stage you have just completed (for the DAP) during the next academic year.
<b>F-WD</b>	You have not passed this stage and cannot continue with your programme of study.
<b>P-RDS_CP_2</b>	You have passed your current stage of study, but you have outstanding reassessment from a previous stage. You may not progress any further until all outstanding re-assessment has been passed.
<b>R-RDS</b> <b>R-RDS_S1</b>	You have not passed this stage and are required to take re-assessment in all the units you have failed in order to progress.
<b>R-RDS_CON</b> <b>R-RDS_CON_S1</b>	You have not passed this stage and are required to take re-assessment in all the units you have failed, that have not been condoned, in order to progress.
<b>R-RDS_CP_2</b>	You have not passed this stage are required to take re-assessment in all your failed units in order to progress. You are also required to take outstanding re-assessment from the previous stage.
<b>R-RDS_F</b>	You have not passed this stage and therefore have not yet met the requirements for your award. Further assessment is required to be eligible for an award.
<b>R-RDS_FOUND</b>	You have not passed this stage and are required to take re-assessment in all the units you have failed, that have not been condoned, in order to progress.
<b>R-RDS_FS</b> <b>R-RDS_FS_S1</b>	You have not passed this stage and are required to take re-assessment in all the units you have failed in order to progress. You have a choice about how you do this. You can either:  1) suspend your studies and take the re-assessment during the next academic year,  OR,  2) repeat this stage during the next academic year.

<b>R-RDS+TRF</b>	You have not passed this stage and are required to take re-assessment in all your failed units in order to progress. You are also required to repeat the previous stage of study following failure of re-assessment from your previous stage.
<b>R-TTDP</b>	You have not passed this stage and cannot continue on the programme you are currently on.  You are required to take re-assessment in order to progress <b>AND</b> you are required to transfer from your current programme to the Designated Alternative Programme (DAP). You will be transferred automatically to the DAP, subject to the results of your re-assessment.
<b>R-TTDP_RPTST</b>	You have not passed this stage and cannot progress to the next stage of the programme. You have a choice about your next steps, you can either:  1) take re-assessment in order to progress to the next stage of the Designated Alternative Programme (DAP).  OR,  2) repeat this stage of your current programme during the next academic year.
<b>R-TTDP+SUSFS</b>	You have not passed this stage and must transfer onto the Designated Alternative Programme (DAP). Further re-assessment is required, but you have a choice about how you do this. You can either:  1) suspend your studies and take third attempt re-assessment during the next academic year,  OR,  2) repeat the stage you have just completed (for the DAP) during the next academic year.
<b>R-TTDP_WD</b>	You have not passed this stage and must transfer onto the Designated Alternative Programme. Further reassessment required,  OR You may choose to withdraw from the programme.

<b>P-AWD_DIP</b>	You have met your programme's requirements for an award and the Board of Studies have awarded you a diploma.
<b>P-AWD_MST</b>	You have met your programme's requirements for an award and the Board of Studies have awarded you a degree.
<b>P-AWD_TT_CER</b>	You have not passed the Masters programme but have been awarded a postgraduate certificate.
<b>P-AWD_TT_DIP</b>	You have not passed the Masters programme but have been awarded a postgraduate diploma.
<b>P-GRD</b>	You have met your programme's requirements for an award and the Board of Studies have awarded you a degree.
<b>P-GRD_DIS</b>	You have met your programme's requirements for an award and the Board of Studies have awarded you a degree, graded distinction.
<b>P-GRD_MERIT</b>	You have met your programme's requirements for an award and the Board of Studies have awarded you a degree, graded merit.
<b>P-GRD_PASS</b>	You have met your programme's requirements for an award and the Board of Studies have awarded you a degree, graded pass.

P-GRD_TT C_DI	You have not passed the Masters programme but have been awarded a postgraduate certificate, graded distinction.
P-GRD_TT C_ME	You have not passed the Masters programme but have been awarded a postgraduate certificate, graded merit.
P-GRD_TT C_PA	You have not passed the Masters programme but have been awarded a postgraduate certificate, graded pass.
P-GRD_TT D_DI	You have not passed the Masters programme but have been awarded a postgraduate diploma, graded distinction.
P-GRD_TT D_ME	You have not passed the Masters programme but have been awarded a postgraduate diploma, graded merit.
P-GRD_TT D_PA	You have not passed the Masters programme but have been awarded a postgraduate diploma, graded pass.

F-AWD	You have not passed your programme of study or achieved an award.

<b>Able to Progress to Next Stage</b>	
C-CS C-CS_S1	You have not yet reached a point in your programme where a progression or award decision is made, you should continue with your studies.
P-CON P-CON_S1 P-CON_CER P-CON_DIP P-CON_DI P_S1	You have passed your current stage and can now progress to the next stage of study. You have failed some units, but as the results were within the condonable range (unit result mark of 35-39 for 40% pass mark units or 45-49 for 50% pass mark units) the Board have agreed that these can be condoned, and you have been awarded the credit for them. You are not required to do any re-assessment.
P-CON_INT P-CON_INT_S1	You may continue with your study. You have failed some units which are within the condonable range (unit result mark of 35-39 for 40% pass mark units or 45-49 for 50% pass mark units). The Board may decide to condone these fails the end of your taught stage if study. The Board will make a decision when your taught stage is complete. Re-assessment <b>may</b> be required.

<b>P-PGS_PASSES</b>	
<b>P-RDS_CHK_S1</b>	You have not yet passed your current stage, but you may continue with study. You are required to take re-assessment in all the units you have failed, that have not been condoned, in order to progress.
<b>P-RDS_CHK_S2</b>	You have not yet passed your current stage, but you may continue with study. You are required to take re-assessment in all the units you have failed, that have not been condoned, in order to progress.
<b>P-RDS_CON_S1</b>	You have not yet passed your current stage, but you may continue with study. Re-assessment will be necessary at the end of the taught stage of study. You have failed some units which are within the condonable range (unit result mark of 35-39 for 40% pass mark units or 45-49 for 50% pass mark units). The Board may decide to condone these fails the end of your taught stage if study. The Board will make a decision when your taught stage is complete.
<b>P-RDS_CON_S2</b>	You have not yet passed your current stage, but you may continue with study. You are required to take re-assessment in all the units you have failed, that have not been condoned, in order to progress.
<b>P-RDS_SRU_S1</b>	You can continue with study, however, you will not be able to start the dissertation stage until the taught stage required unit re-assessment has been completed.

<b>D-YNC</b>	The Board of Examiners for Programmes has not yet recommended an end of stage decision to the Board of Studies because you have not undertaken all your units for this stage.

<b>R-RDS</b>	You have not passed this stage and cannot continue with your programme of study. You are required to take re-assessment in all the units you have failed in order to progress.
<b>R-RDS_CHK</b>	You have not passed this stage and cannot continue with your programme of study. You are required to take re-assessment in all the units you have failed, that have not been condoned, in order to progress

<b>R-RDS_CON_S1</b>	
<b>R-RDS_SRU</b>	You have not passed your current stage and cannot progress to the next stage of your programme of study. You are required to take re-assessment in all the units you have failed and will not be able to start the dissertation stage until the taught stage re-assessment has been successfully completed.
<b>R-TTDP_CER</b>	You are unable to stay on the current programme, re-assessment is required in order to transfer to a Postgraduate Certificate programme.
<b>R-TTDP_DIP</b>	You are unable to stay on the current programme, re-assessment is required in order to transfer to a Postgraduate Diploma programme.
